JBLM Regulation 210-1, para. 7-8. Crimes and Incident Reporting.

All crimes or incidents affecting the maintenance of good order and discipline committed on the Joint Base Lewis-McChord will be reported to the Police Desk Sergeant by the most expeditious means.

ALARACT 110/2010, para. 3C(3) - The Director of Emergency Services (DES) and Provost Marshal (PM) Office should serve as the office of primary responsibility for receiving suspicious activity reports.
