PFC Wolney enlisted in the Army in February 1989 and was selected for OCS where he was commissioned as a 2LT in Armor in Sep 1989. LT Wolney deployed to Camp Garry Owen, Korea from 1990-1992 where he served as a Tank Platoon Leader, a Scout Platoon Leader, and a Cavalry Troop Executive Officer. LT Wolney then became the Armor Company Executive Officer at Fort Hunter Liggett, CA developing and testing new equipment for the US Army until he attended the Armor Advance Course in 1994. Upon graduation, CPT Wolney assumed duties as the Adjutant, 2BCT, 4ID, Fort Hood, TX and assumed command of C/3-67 AR from 1996-1998 where his company was the runner up for the Draper Award. After Command, CPT Wolney was promoted to MAJ while serving as an active duty advisor to 1-198 AR BN, 155 SAB, MSARNG. MAJ Wolney then deployed to Germany where he assumed duties as the G3, Chief of Training, 1AD. MAJ Wolney deployed with 1AD to Iraq as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom in 2003 and then returned to assume duties as the DPTMS, 221st BSB, Wiesbaden, Germany. MAJ Wolney returned from Germany to assume duties as the S3 and XO, 5-15 CAV 19D10 OSUT, Fort Knox, KY. LTC Wolney was selected to command the 2nd Combined Arms Battalion (CAB) where he and his Soldiers executed testing of all Future Combat System equipment. After Command, LTC Wolney became the DCO for 1st Armor Training Brigade. LTC Wolney was asked to come to Fort Wainwright, AK in 2007 to help fix property accountability issues within 1/25 SBCT and served as the 1/25 SBCT Executive Officer. Upon deployment in 2008, LTC Wolney assumed duties as the Diyala Operations Command Transition Team (DOC-TT) chief where he coordinated all activities between the Three-Star Iraqi HQs and MND-N. Upon redeployment, LTC Wolney assumed duties in USARAK G4, Chief of Operations at Fort Wainwright in October 2009. In December 2010, LTC Wolney retired after 22 years of service and became a Department of the Army Civilian working in the same capacity for USARAK G4. In July 2013, Mr. Wolney was selected to become the Director, DOL for FWA/JBER ASA where he continues to serve Soldiers today.
