Mr. Jerry C. Walsh served as a commission officer Ordnance Corps for 25 years until retirement. Commissioned through ROTC from Southwest Missouri State University with a BS in Business, later received a MS in Procurement Management from Webster University, and is a graduate of Command and General Staff College. He is a life member of the Institute of Supply Management and holds national certification as Certified Purchasing Manager (C.P.M.)

He was selected as a RA officer as a Captain and during the Army career served as Company Commander of an Individual Training Company, HQ Company School Brigade, and DS/GS Maintenance Company, and subsequently as a MMC commander in Germany. Other assignments include Joint Military Assistance Command – Korea, DA Staff, USFK G/J/C4 Ammunitions Division Chief, and Director of Operations Sierra Army Depot. Awards include Legion of Merit, Bronze Star, two Defense Meritorious Service Medals, two MSMs, three ARCOMs, and various service awards including Meritorious Unit Commendation, foreign awards, and combat patch.

Following retirement from the Army worked both as a consultant and for various commercial firms including Vinnell Corporation in Saudi Arabia as Training Division Chief in support of the Royal Saudi Land Forces in the incorporation of the BFV into the Royal Saudi Land Forces and as the Chief of the Field Office at the Saudi Ordnance School. Later with Vinnell subsequently acquired by Northrop Grumman as the Supply Division Manager, on the NTC Contract for the Logistics Support Services Contract managed by FORSCOM.

He accepted a position with the U.S. Government as the Deputy to the Commander, Echelon Above Brigade (EAB) in 2006. While in the position served on a detail as the Deputy to the Commander, 916<sup>th</sup> SPD BDE (concurrently). In November 2008 accepted the position as the Director of Logistics, FICA Garrison.
