What does a Construction Truck Driver Do:

Any place that you can drive your vehicle a construction truck driver was involved in the moving of men and material. You may be building a parking lot at a shopping center. It could be streets for a new neighborhood. Possibly a new mountain pass or the straightening of an existing pass. You may be repaving a city street with asphalt, chip sealing a county road, or concrete paving an Interstate highway. You may even be at an airport or military base working on a runway.

Our equipment includes Dump Trucks and Trailers, Belly Dumps, Side Dumps, Water Trucks, Sweepers, Articulated Off Highway Trucks, Solid Frame Off Highway Trucks, Mixer Trucks and Buses just to name a few. You may be working directly on the project or hauling material to and from the project.

What is VET's?

- VET's is designed for Active-Duty Service-Members transitioning from Military Service that are interested in a career as a Construction Truck Driver.
- VET's is a 6 week training program that is held at the Stone Education Center, 6242 Colorado Avenue, JBLM Lewis-Main and at a gravel pit in nearby Dupont, WA.
- VET's is part of a Washington State Approved Apprenticeship training program.
- Successful graduates are placed in a 3,000 hour paid apprenticeship program in WA State.
- As a Teamster Construction member, entry level apprentices begin at 70% of the Journey level rate with full family medical and a very attractive retirement program.

Must Have:

- Be on Active Duty with a Separation/Retirement date one month either side of the class end date
- Secure Command authorization to participate
- Provide a copy of your Army Enlisted Record Brief (ERB) or copy of Records Review from virtual Military Personnel flight (vMPF, Air Force only)
- Receive a Fully Honorable; Honorable; and/or General discharge
- Be 21 years of age.
- Be able to read and speak the English language.
- Be able to obtain a Class A Commercial Drivers License with a Hazmat Endorsement.
- Be able to pass a DOT physical.
- Provide a copy of your State driving record available online from your State DMV office.
