6. New Business:

(a) Mr. Silva updated the council members on the status of RAD 2012: Hangar #10 is still not available. Mr. Silva has been working with CMSgt Warren, McChord Field, trying to get Hangar #10 for use on the day of the RAD. Mr. Silva met with Ms. Gloria Irizarry, the Exchange Assistant manager, in reference to door prizes. Ms. Gloria Irizarry said that they would provide door prizes as similar as the items that they have provided in the past. Mr. Silva will pick-up the door prizes the week of 14 May with the help of the RAD Detail NCOIC. Mr. Silva will be meeting with CMSgt Drake, CMSgt Warren's replacement, to try and get the use of Hangar #10.
