

# Proposed Mitigation Measures for Significant Impacts

## Fort Lewis

### **Noise** (Alternatives 2, 3, and 4)

- Fort Lewis would establish a board to maintain a continuing dialogue and to periodically meet with the Tribes and nearby communities on noise concerns

### **Traffic and Transportation** (Alternative 4)

- Fort Lewis would install new traffic lights, change timing of existing traffic lights, and/or construct additional lanes to improve the Levels of Service (LOS) at significantly impacted intersections
- Fort Lewis would participate in State and local transportation studies and provide input on reconstruction of the I-5 DuPont interchange required to mitigate the significant impact to LOS at this interchange

### **Socioeconomics** (Alternative 4)

- Fort Lewis would maintain outreach and close coordination with surrounding school districts regarding near- and long-term potential stationing actions that affect school enrollment

## YTC

### **Biological Resources** (Alternatives 2, 3, 4)

- YTC would rehabilitate the majority of training lands that are impacted by fire and maneuver training, with a focus on recovering the community types that have been degraded
