Leftover household products that contain toxic ingredients require special disposal to avoid harming human health or the environment.

Household hazardous waste (HHW) should never be poured down the drain, onto the ground, into storm sewers or thrown in the trash.

HHW product labels may include the terms: Caution, Warning, Danger, Poison, Keep out of reach of children, Harmful if swallowed, Aerosol, Caustic, Volatile, Flammable, etc.

JBLM HHW Collection Site is intended for JBLM residents only. Those residing off-base should take HHW to one of the following locations:

Materials currently being accepted:

Aluminum cans

Appliances – anything with a cord except **NO** refrigerators/freezers, water coolers or A/C units

Books & Media

Cardboard – please flatten

Clean wood waste – no painted, treated, stained, chipboard or particle board, pallets ok

Clothes – clothing, blankets, sheets, curtains, bags, tents, duffle bags, and any other items made of fabric

Computer Plastics – computer parts, circuit boards, keyboards, fax machines, printers, cell phones, PDAs and computer cables

Cooking Oil

Electronics – (non military owned) computer monitors, laptops and TV's

Food Waste – food only, no trash

Glass bottles and jars – no ceramic, plates, cups or window glass

Lead Acid Batteries

Metal – lawn chairs, barbeques, items must be mostly metal

Microwaves – please remove glass plate

Mixed paper – newsprint, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, cereal boxes, soda drink boxes, and phone books



Plastic bags – shrink & bubble wrap, lumber wrap, and garment bags

Plastic bottles – drink containers, buckets, tubs (no lids), planting pots, and soap containers. **NO** plastic containers previously containing petroleum or gas products. **NO** plastic drink cups.

Plastic/Metal Breakage – baby strollers, baby swings, car seats, playground toys, basketball hoops, hard plastic pools, Rubbermaid storage items, laundry baskets, plastic hangers, etc.

Plastic Shipping Pallets

Shoes

Toner / Ink Cartridges

Yard Waste – grass, leaves, bushes and woody debris. **NO** rocks, sod, animal waste, or garbage. **NO** plastic yard waste bags, all bags must be emptied and placed in the trash.

Absolutely NO... hazardous materials or hazardous waste will be accepted. Household hazardous waste must be taken to Environmental Operations building 1210 (see backside). **NO** freezers, refrigerators, water coolers or a/c units.

Military items & property book items must be turned in through the **DOL** or **DLA** channels for proper disposition.

Garbage will not be accepted at the Recycling Centers, illegal dumpers will be prosecuted.
